

Land scape contract Growing.

Riverdene Nurseries grow a wide range of plants on landscape use. The nursery is prepared to grow plants on contract at competitive rates subject to the following conditions

1. Plants are a living thing and are a growing item and are subject to variation in prevailing weather conditions. Riverdene nursery is not responsible for plant stock failure due to weather conditions or the seasonable unavailability of seed or other propagating materials
2. Riverdene nurseries recognise that landscape projects can be delayed by many factors including weather conditions, breakdowns, heritage, and archaeological conditions to name just a few. However plant stock keep's on growing and represents a cost to be maintained and if delays beyond 8 weeks occur the following will apply.
 - a) The client **must** notify Riverdene nurseries of the expected delays.
 - b) Depending on the species being grown a maintenance charge of 5% per month or part thereof will be charged to maintain the stock. In the case of prolonged delays (6 months or more) the stock may need to be potted on at the client's expense.
 - c) If delays of longer than 8 weeks occur and Riverdene nurseries is not advised by the client we reserve the right to sell the plant stock on the open market to recover cost.
3. Riverdene nurseries reserve the right at their discretion to ask for a 10% deposit on any advance orders or growing contract.
4. By placing a signed order the client is deemed to have agreed to the above conditions
