RIVERDENE SELECTED FRUIT TREE LIST

STONE FRUITS	
PEACH Allyn Bank	A dual purpose fruit tree with masses of dark pink/red semi double flowers and small yellow fleshed clingstone fruits. Ripens late January, fruit is very aromatic & flavoursome. Very hardy & easy to grow.
PLUM Cherry	Hardy & adaptable with cherry sized fruits in early December. Useful for eating, pies, jams & winemaking.
PLUM Yarrahapini Blood	Self-Pollinating cherry - blood plum that is also a dual purpose variety with deep red leaves and striking pink flowers in Spring & crops of plums in late December.
PLUM Riverdene Blood	Hardy & free fruiting plum with dark red flesh. Bears very heavy crops. Compact grower to about 3 metres high. Origin of this variety is unknown, but it was rescued from an old orchard planted in the 1870's.
PLUM Wilson's Early	Form of Cherry Plum. Red skinned with yellow flesh. Bears heavy crops of large cherry sized fruit in December.
PLUM Gulf Ruby	"Gulf Ruby" is a new name for a superior form of Prunus angustifolia (the American plum). Juicy red skinned fruit with yellow flesh. Hardy plum that ripens early.

ORANGE – The Pub Orange	This Orange grew at the Gresford pub for nearly 100 years and had to be removed when the pub did extensions in 2012. Derived from the well-known Paterson River seedling, Hardy & sweet.
WALLMARIN	A unique seedling that arose in the nursery and was rescued and planted by our daughter. Fairly thorny but bears large, juicy, sweet Mandarin type fruit that begins to ripen from late September to early October. Fruit is best left on tree as long as possible as it ripens & sweetens very slowly. Fruit darkens to deep orange when close to ripe.

A LITTLE BIT DIFFERENT	
JAPANESE RAISIN TREE	Deciduous tree with unusual fruit that tastes like raisins. Very cold hardy, highly coloured autumn foliage. Fast growing.
DAVIDSONS PLUM	Native fruit tree that is best grown in semi-shade. Bears heavy crops of dark skinned plums along the trunk. Very tangy eaten raw, excellent for jams, jellies and drinks.
MULBERRY – Weeping Black Beauty	An untidy grower that bears heavy crops of medium size black mulberries. Hardy & easily grown variety.
CEYLON HILL CHERRY	<i>Rhodomyrtus tomentosa</i> Attractive evergreen shrub to 3 metres high with masses of pink flowers over a long period followed by masses of sweet purple/green edible berries in late autumn or early spring. Best in full sun and good soil, frost hardy and hardy to moderate drought.
